Acosta is a visual artist based in Toledo (Spain). Formed in the Gijonesa Association of Fine Arts and in the School of Arts and Crafts of Salamanca.

Acosta has been active since the mid-1970s and has collaborated with many of the best Spanish galleries, participating in group and individual exhibitions, as well as in contemporary art fairs in Spain and Germany.

"In recent years, my work incorporates the fascination of travel. Around the year 2006 I begin to represent architectures and also maps, resolved within a figurative language, with respect to previous stages of more abstract architectural concepts. I am inspired on the one hand by the suggestions of the buildings and architectures observed in my travels, I also reflect the peculiar elements of the trip itself, such as the postcards and photographs of monuments and architectures, together with the itineraries of the maps, all of this fixes the collection of memories that the traveler (tourist) brings with it; the old conception of travel as a Grand Tour, formative and transformative" Luis Acosta.



Bachelor of Fine Arts and Master of Art from the Complutense University of Madrid. Master in Creation and Research from the Complutense University of Madrid. Teacher in cultural centers of the Madrid City Council in the areas of Drawing and Painting.

Vallejo develops his universe using children's toys and games. With them he explains intimate feelings and sensations. These playful narratives are channeled into characters that have a kind of life of their own, as happens in literary characters. His activity is shown mainly in the field of painting and drawing but also in sculpture and installation.

His work has been seen in numerous exhibitions in galleries and art fairs throughout the country, highlighting his participation in the ABC Cultural stand at ARCO Madrid in 2017.

His most recent work approaches the work of artists such as Edward Hopper, Chirico or Nigel Van Wieck. Recreate visual snippets of American neighborhoods, slices of ideal homes, and Bel Air Chevrolets. From his hand we look at these neighborhoods as everyday walkers, flâneurs who enjoy the decorative casing that Americanity offers. These works ask us, precisely, about that way of building an imaginary, an aesthetic stereotype that shows the American dream as a standardized matter, close to totalitarian uniformity.

Photographer. Self-taught, he began his professional career at the end of the nineties. Before focusing his work on artistic photography, he has traveled through almost all areas of the photographic world (portraits, fashion, advertising, architecture, interior design,...). He has worked for international firms such as Red Bull, Dior or Hermès. His photographs have been published in different media and magazines such as El Mundo, El País, Absolute or Mondo Sonoro. He has exhibited in numerous galleries and his work has received various awards, among others, the 1st Prize of the V Jalón Ángel International Photography Award and the First Prize of the International Tour Film Festival of Rome 2015.

Chacón has confirmed himself as a reference in his field for his artistic projects, the treatment of light in his images and the staging he organizes to make his peculiar way of telling stories a reality. His work seeks -starting from a solid technical experience- to return to that innocent look where the image becomes the place of light and of the moment.











Simon Zabell (Málaga 1970) is an Anglo-Spanish artist living and working in Spain. After studying Painting and Sculpture at the University of Granada, he developed an interest in the effects of narrative on painting and installation art, which lead him to study Theatre Design under Philip Prowse at the Slade School of Fine Art in London. Since then he has been working using mainly painting, sculpture and installation to develop projects with a strong narrative and scenographic content, which are usually based on works by previous creators such as radical French author Alain Robbe-Grillet or composer Karlheinz Stockhausen.

These projects have been exhibited extensively in venues in the United Kingdom, Spain and Sweden, and in numerous art fairs such as SCOPE LONDON, PINTA NY, ARCO, VOLTA etc.

As from late 2014 Zabell worked on an ambitious project, **Our Men in Tahiti**, based on extensive research into Robert Louis Stevenson's late novel The Ebb-Tide, and which also includes a short documentary following his creative process. ([Watch full movie here](#))

Zabell's current ongoing project, **Bravo Nuevo Mundo**, is his most abstract to date and is the result of an inquiry into the musical idea of groove, and the expressive capacity of low-pitch sound translated into visual form.

Simon Zabell is Professor of Sculpture at the University of Granada.




